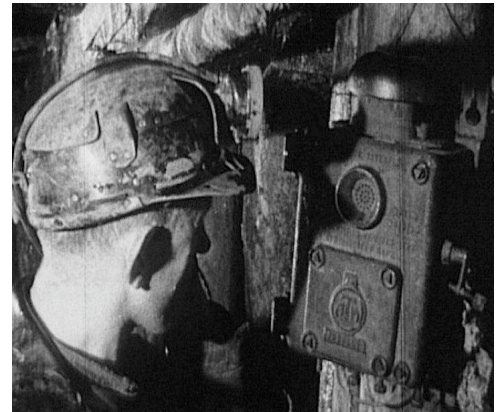
**The 7th Annual Northeast Historic Film Summer Film Symposium
